CONFIRMATION PREPARATION IS RUN THROUGH ANIMATE (the diocesan youth service in conjunction with

our Catholic schools). YOU CAN STILL JOIN THESE ONLINE SESSIONS EVEN IF YOU ARE NOT AT A CATHOLIC SCHOOL. If your child is in Year 8 and would like to receive the sacrament of confirmation, please register at liver-poolcalled.co.uk. Registration is open from Monday 13 January to Monday 17 March 2025.

Join the Animate team and special guests live for the Sacrament of Confirmation Online Preparation Sessions on 1 May and 15 May from 16.30-18.00 on the Animate Youth YouTube channel. No log in required. This session will offer a reminder of some of the work done in schools on Gifts of the Spirit, Saints, Rite of Confirmation. You will also hear how Confirmation has affected different people in the Archdiocese. This is to run alongside your Local Parish/Deanery preparation.

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL.

Thank you to all our new Parish Pastoral Council Members, who met for the first time last week - particularly those who have come on from the Farington area and other new members. We had a productive meeting planning for Lent and Holy Week, engagement with our parish schools, and on-going building maintenance - especially the refurbishment of the Presbytery and the repair of the leak over the baptistry at St Mary's (you will be able to see the damage on the wall behind the Holy Water and very severely in the sacristy.)

WECOME NEXT WEEKEND.

I'm sure you will welcome some visiting priests next weekend, who will be offering the Masses while I am away working on a Catholic project in France which I am involved in: St Peter's at Saint Pierre de Maillé in the Nouvelle-Aquitaine region in Mid-West France.

On Saturday evening, Mgr John Goddard will celebrate the Mass at St Catherine's. Mgr is the Parish Priest at Our Lady, Help of Christians at Tarleton but before his reception into the Catholic Church, he was formerly the Anglican Bishop of Burnley.

On Sunday for both Masses, Fr Simon Gore will celebrate the Masses at St Mary's. Fr Simon is the Director of "Animate" the Archdiocesan Youth Service, which is based at St Mary's Lowe House in St Helens.

READERS: for those who did not receive the new protocol instruction sheet, they are available in the sacristy, so as streamline and unify our proclamation of the Word more effectively. Thank you.

ST MARY'S FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS: Thank you to the parents & children for the renewed commitment to attend Mass each Sunday. The children's presence at Mass greatly enhances our Sunday experience and is much commented on by other parishioners. Don't forget to sign "Golden Book" at the back of church for the children to make a record of their prayers and attendance at Mass for each Sunday until their First Communion as a gift for Jesus. Attendance at Mass & the preparation sessions are a pre-requisite of being able to make First Communions.

FIRST CONFESSIONS: These are now taking place over 4 Saturday mornings in church, so the children can experience the Sacrament in it's normal place, to hopefully encourage them to come again in the ordinary course of their spiritual lives. There are 4 slots on each of the mornings for you to sign up for, the times allotted will also give enough space for parents and siblings to come to Confession as well, to set the best example for the children. As it is said in the Sacrament of Baptism, "Parents are the first and best teachers of their children."

PARISH TRIP TO FRANCE: Over the past three years parishioners from St Catherine's have enjoyed a parish holiday in France at St Peter's International College in Saint Pierre de Maillé (the venue is in the process of changing from having been an active Catholic School to now functioning as a pilgrimage/conference/retreat centre/ holiday venue.

In the hope that we will be able to go again this year, the following have been identified as possible dates, to include the Feast of the Assumption of Our Lady, which is the village's festal day, so we can enjoy the cele-

brations, including a fantastic fireworks display over the River Gartempe, which flows through the village.

Monday 11th August. 13.40 Departing from Manchester.

Wednesday 20th August: 15.25 Departing from Limoges.

Cost per person (no single room supplements) around £650 (excluding baggage and insurance).

This includes flights and transfer to and from airports.

Staying at St Peter's College in Saint-Pierre-de-Maillé in the beautiful Poitou-Charentes region. Daily visits to local attractions, picturesque towns &

villages, local Chateau & historic cities. Breakfast and Dinner (including 86-56-PIERRE-de-MAILLI wine) included each day. Lunch included on days when we are not out for the whole day, for example, in Poitiers (Cathedral & historic town). Accommodation is en-suite in twin or single rooms. There are also a limited number of family apartments. Daily Mass in the chapel of Our Lady of the Rosary.

The building is a 200 year old convent, founded by local saints St André Hubert and St Jeanne-Elisabeth Bichier, whose shrine is in the neighboring village.
